Airfare: Each student is responsible for making her or his own airline reservations and purchasing the ticket. As soon as you have bought your ticket, send this information to the director of *Amigos del Sur*, Prof. Andrés Lema-Hincapié. We recommend arrival in Buenos Aires two or three days before the program starts date and leaving two or three days after the program ends.

¹ Nonrefundable fee for enrollment documents.

² Fee for room and breakfast is nonrefundable.

³ Only one-half the registration fee is refundable, should the student fail to participate in the program. The fee is nonrefundable if the student has to withdraw from the program for any reason during the weeks that the program is in session.

⁴ Airfare will depend on your city of origin and the time when you buy your ticket

⁵ The cell phone fee is mandatory, in order to follow *Amigos del Sur* security recommendations.

Study materials: In Buenos Aires, the student will receive a list of required materials. These may include books, magazines, newspapers, CDs, DVDs, theater and cinema tickets, trips by taxi, bus, train, boat, and metro, ingredients for cooking recipes, paintbrushes, photocopies, film, and scholarly implements and supplies.

Pocket money: In addition to this estimated amount for daily expenses, in the event of unplanned expenses we recommend that the student have an internationally accepted credit card (Visa, Master Card, or American Express, for example).

Cellular phone: For purposes of security, effectiveness in teaching, and social convenience, most *Amigos del Sur* students rent a cell phone while in Buenos Aires. This enables the students to be in continual contact with their parents, professors, friends, and hosts, thus creating a network of companionship that provides cohesion and security for each member of the program.

Reciprocity Tax Fee: Valid for 10 year, this fee allows you to entry Argentina with a valid passport. It is mandatory for all US citizens and Argentine immigration officers started collecting this fee on December 30, 2009. US travelers can pay this fee in cash or by using their credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express).

NO ACADEMIC CREDITS INVOLVED: Please, note, that Amigos del Sur program does not offer university credits. All are students enroll because of their sincere interest in learning Spanish and experience the wonderful culture of Argentina. This ensures the high quality of our program. All participants are committed to the academic success of *Amigos del Sur*.
